**DISCUSSION and INFORMATIONAL ITEM(S):**

- Feedback from Shunu Shrestha on City of Superior Adult Entertainment Ordinance:
  - Had preliminary discussion on the first recommendation made by Shunu with the City of Minneapolis Human Trafficking Office.
    - Sec. 86-50. Sale or display of certain visual sexually explicit materials to minors prohibited.(b.)(2.)
  - Commission Members need more time to review
  - Want to inquire with the City of Superior legal council after any recommendations are referred by the Commission
- Feedback from Kim Nelson on City of Superior Wage Theft, Tax Evasion, Building and Trades Licensing ordinances:
  - Need for Responsible Bidder Ordinance enforced and look at pathways for this to be useful to the Labor Trafficking

- Changes in Labor Trafficking are moving forward in MN legislation addressing this issue. Kim will look into what is happening in WI for legislation and items to support in Wisconsin to address labor trafficking
- Labor associated City of Superior Ordinances were shared with Kim Nelson and Human Trafficking Commission
  
- Laura has been in contact with the President of the Tavern League, Keith Kern re: Tavern's open to Human Trafficking posters in restrooms or training
  
- Survey to be sent to Commission Members by Joe and Tatiana in the future.
  - Will send out in 3 weeks, prior to the meeting
  - Will pull from Community Plan from NHTTAC
  - Kim wants to talk about how we can incorporate labor trafficking
  - Building a trade career pathway for survivors
