Mayor Jim Paine asks that voters with an absentee ballot, please drop your ballot off at the drop box in front of the Government Center, 1316 North 14th Street, Superior. Voters should no longer mail in ballots, as they may not reach the City Clerk's Office by Election Day. Ballots received after Election Day, Tuesday, April 7th, **will not be counted.**

Voters or the Press with questions about ballots or the election process can call the City Clerk at 715-395-7200. Friday, April 3rd is the final day for in person voting at the Government Center. All regular polling sites will be open on Election Day and will feature curbside voting.

Also:

City of Superior's Spring Cleanup is cancelled for 2020. Free landfill days, traditionally held in late April and early May are tentatively postponed to the Saturdays of May 30th and June 6th. Free landfill days are open to residents of the City of Superior for dumping of household items.
