



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS ON CITY OF SUPERIOR
HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
NEEDS AND FAIR HOUSING CHOICE**

The City of Superior is designated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) as an entitlement community for the receipt of direct funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. HUD requires entitlement communities to give citizens an opportunity to provide comments on the City’s use of CDBG funds. In particular, the City of Superior is required to request comments on community development needs and fair housing choice.

Public hearings will be held before the Common Council for the purpose of receiving public comment. The time and location is as follows:

Two public hearings will be held as follows:

1. Housing and Community Development Needs: The first public hearing will be for the purpose of receiving comment on the needs of Superior regarding housing and community development. **Special consideration is given to the needs of persons with low and moderate incomes and those persons living in CDBG-eligible neighborhoods (Census tracts 203, 206, 210 and 211).**

2. Fair Housing Choice: The second public hearing will be to take comments on fair housing choice from individuals, Realtors, landlords, lenders, housing advocates, service providers and others concerned about or knowledgeable of fair housing practices in Superior. **People are encouraged to testify regarding discriminatory housing practices and lack of opportunities for housing based on sex, color, disability, national origin, family status, lawful source of income, race, sexual orientation, religion, marital status, age and ancestry.**

The public is encouraged provide written comments directly to the City of Superior, Community Development Office, and/or provide comments at the public hearing. **Written comments should be received at or before the public hearing.**
