



A SUPERIOR SOLUTION TO UNWANTED MEDICATIONS

Have unwanted medications? Protect your family and the environment by properly disposing of them at the pharmaceutical drop box at the City of Superior Police Department.

Keeping unwanted pharmaceuticals can lead to theft, prescription drug abuse, and accidental poisoning. Disposal by flushing or throwing in the garbage can lead to water pollution and harm to fish and wildlife.

What can I bring?

Your household's prescription and over-the-counter medication in any form. Syringes, needles, and thermometers are NOT allowed.

How?

Cross names off prescription bottles. Bring to drop box in lobby of police station between 8 and 4:30 Monday through Friday. The drop off is completely confidential.
