COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT  
(CDBG) PROGRAM**

The City of Superior projects that approximately \$862,769 of funding will be available under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for the funding period of January 1 – December 31, 2020. This public notice is to solicit proposals for funding. Applications and program information will be available at the Planning Department, Government Center, 1316 North 14<sup>th</sup> Street, Room 210, Superior, WI 54880 or by emailing [andersonk@ci.superior.wi.us](mailto:andersonk@ci.superior.wi.us).

Application packets are now available. Completed applications must be received by the Planning Department before 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 8, 2019.

There are many basic eligible activities that can be funded through the CDBG program. Generally, proposals should be classified within one of the four following program areas:

1. Public Facilities and Improvements
2. Public Services
3. Affordable Housing and Housing Rehabilitation
4. Special Economic Development

Proposed activities must meet criteria for one of the following CDBG National Objectives:

- Benefit low and moderate income people
- Aid in the prevention of slum and blight
- Meet a need having a particular urgency (urgent need)

Applicants are encouraged to review the City of Superior 2016 – 2020 Consolidated Strategy and Plan for Housing and Community Development prior to preparing an application.
