YOU MUST PROVIDE PHOTO ID WHEN YOU VOTE, IN ORDER TO PROVE WHO YOU ARE.



Vote absentee BEFORE Election Day, or Vote IN PERSON on Election Day with any one of the following:

- Wisconsin driver license*
- WI DOT-issued photo ID card*
- U.S. passport*
- Military ID card*
- Certificate of naturalization issued within the last 2 years
- Unexpired receipt for a Wisconsin Driver License or a WI State ID
- Unexpired tribal ID card for a federally-recognized Wisconsin Tribe
- College ID & Proof of Enrollment (POE):
 - ID not expired
 - Wisconsin Accredited
 - With Issuance Date
 - With Student Signature
 - With Expiration Date
 - POE varies with each college—usually a separate document (may be electronic), such as a class schedule, student services fee statement, or enrollment verification form. If unsure, please ask your college.

* The expiration date must be after the date of the General Election, **currently November 3, 2020.**

PROOF OF ENROLLMENT

Proof of Enrollment varies for each college. It is a separate document (may be electronic), such as a class schedule or enrollment verification form.

If you are not sure about your proof of enrollment; please ask your college.

Your college ID card **MUST** have all of the following to be used for voting:

- Photo
- Signature
- Issuance Date
- Expiration date that is not expired
- Your school must be a WI accredited college

* The expiration date must be after the date of the last General Election, **currently November 3, 2020.**
